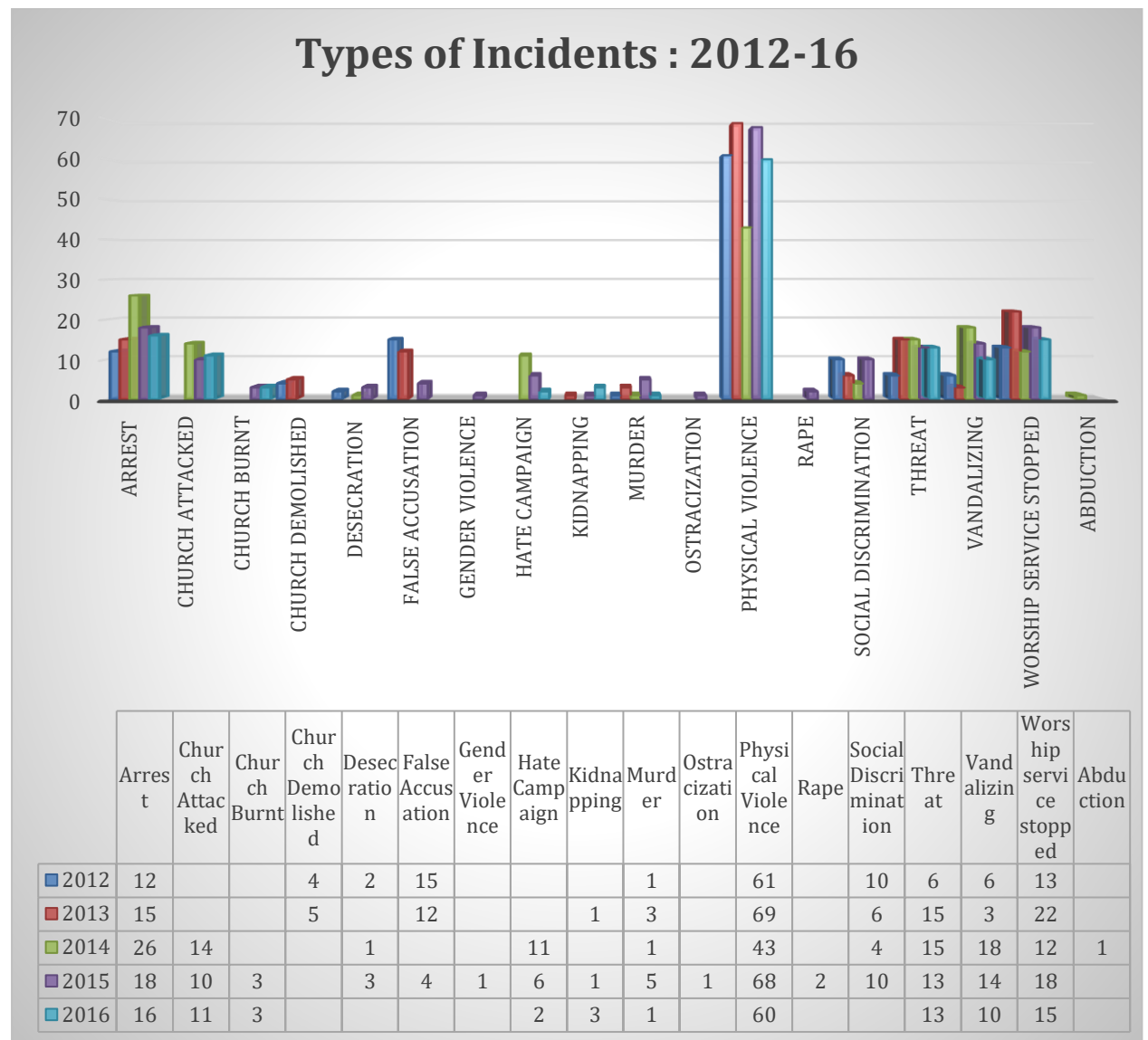

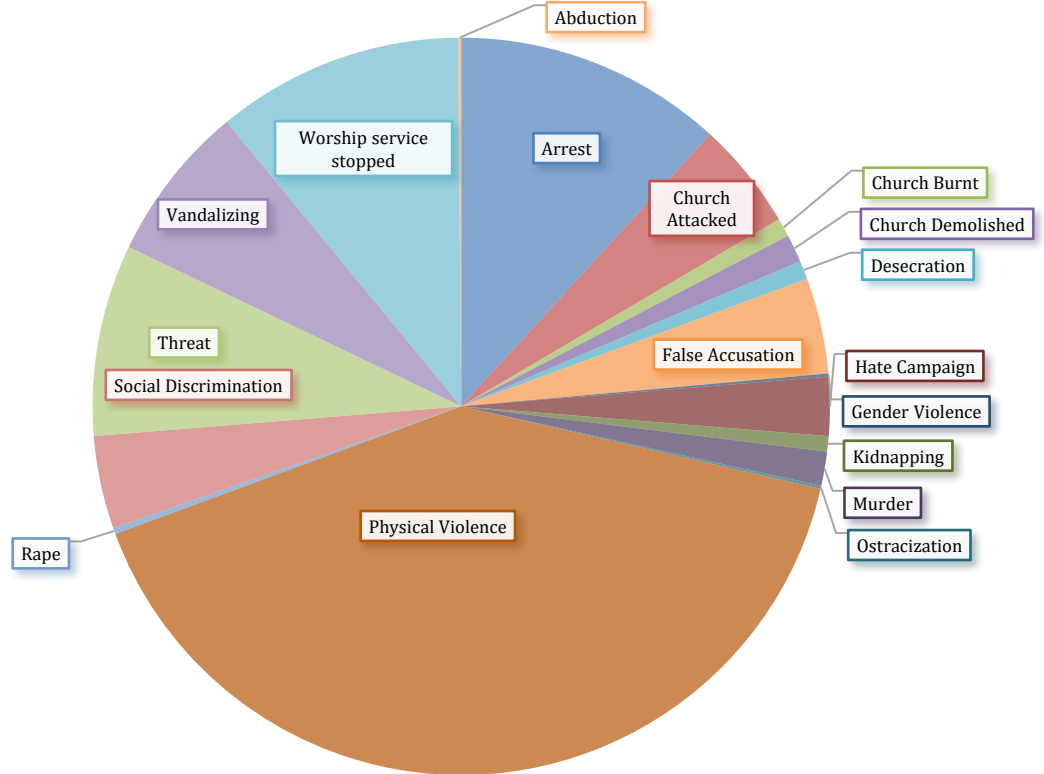

Kandhamal – A Case Study on miscarriage of justice

Christians in Kandhamal district of Orissa were targeted twice in quick succession. The first attack came in December 2007 after Christians were told not to celebrate Christmas. Waves of attacks on Christian homes in several blocks of the district left over 600 Christian homes destroyed.

This was followed by a full-fledged pogrom starting 24th August 2008. The Kandhamal story has been now recorded carefully by a band of committed Christian activists, and law researchers. The well known Supreme Court lawyer, Vrinda Grover, has conducted two analyses based on law data to comment on how justice has been deliberately distorted or denied, by acts of commission and omission involving the police, the politicians, and even the judicial personnel. The Catholic activist, Fr Ajay Singh has narrated the course of the crime, investigation and justice process on the occasion of the eighth anniversary of the Kandhamal pogrom. Fr Ajay was head of the social work programme of the Catholic Church in Kandhamal and had a close encounter with the system and the actual violence.

Suresh Capuchin, the Editor in chief of Indian Currents, perhaps India's only Church owned political weekly magazine, recently wrote: "Over hundred lives lost; scores maimed; many sexually assaulted; thousands of houses torched and reduced to debris; a few hundred churches, worshipping places and institutions razed to the ground; more than half lakh people displaced. This was the score board of 'achievements' of Sangh Parivar elements in the riots unleashed in the wake of the murder of Swami Lakshmanananda, a leader of anti-Christian movement and 'ghar wapsi' programmes, on August 23, 2008."¹

There are several issues that need a close look on the eighth anniversary of the gruesome events that put the nation to shame in the eyes of the world. First, the lackadaisical manner the administration went about bringing the guilty to book. An affidavit by the Odisha government in the Supreme Court blew lid of the apathy of the powers-that-be to the victims.² Almost one-third of the 827 cases registered were closed because the police could not trace the culprits. Out of the 362 trials completed, only 78 ended up in conviction. The original complaints numbered over 6,000: One per family.

Most FIR's were not even entertained by the police, and are lost forever. The fact that the Supreme Court was constrained to ask the State authorities to investigate such huge number of acquittals tells its own tale. Most of the cases have fell because witnesses turned hostile due to threat to their life and limb. The government failed in its basic duty to protect the witnesses of the most dreadful crimes.³ The accused and their cronies are reportedly threatening witnesses through various means. In some cases, victims have gone on record stating that they face hostile crowd of lawyers, accused and their buddies even in court premises, making a mockery of justice. There are also instances of Christians, reportedly charged with trumped up cases, languishing in jails. The administration has not been empathetic to the cause of survivors of one of the worst riots in the history of independent India. It announced a pittance of compensation, which the Supreme Court in a recent order has doubled. The State government has not done much to infuse confidence among those who have fled Kandhamal fearing for their life. Hardly any steps have been taken to bring back those who have migrated to other cities within Odisha and other States.

Writer and activist Dr. John Dayal has in his several reports before Indian and international human rights organisations, pointed to the fact that the fresh investigations ordered by the court⁴ also strengthen our position in another

public interest writ before the Supreme Court which seeks fresh probes into the violence as witnesses were intimidated by the Sangh Parivar and local criminals, or the State departments of prosecution had failed to do their duty. It needs to be also remembered at all times that the victims were Dalits and indigenous people, Tribals. They are the poorest of the poor in India, and the most vulnerable. But justice is not just winning or losing a criminal case, or some criminals going to jail. It is a comprehensive situation. The victims must feel the state cares for them as citizens; they must feel they have been rehabilitated, that there is employment, that the children have overcome the break in their education, and that women who were assaulted are healed psychologically and spiritually. While the people have moved back into their homes, most have lost their livelihood, their fields, and their peace of mind. Much remains to be done for them. Security, a feeling of safety, is still lacking in many areas.

Justice is sampled and gauged in collective data, but it is in individual cases that the intensity of the violence and the gruesomeness of the experience are sharply etched.

Many women were raped, and at least one young Hindu woman was murdered in the violence. The rape of Nuns is a tragic reality of India that no one really wants to speak of in academic or other conversations.

The rape of the Kandhamal nun, Sister M as she is called because the Supreme Court has ruled that victims of sexual violence must be allied the dignity of anonymity, tells her own story.

The case of Sister M.

Sr. M. has been a frequent presence in the District and Sessions Courts in Cuttack in the state. She had been summoned by the defence lawyers to be cross-examined after she had identified five of the men who had assaulted her and her colleague, Fr. Thomas Chellan. She was the solitary witness to the assault on the priest.

Her own experience in the trial of her rapists had been a painful one. The magistrate recording her statement would not do so honestly. The high court was remiss. Ultimately the Supreme Court had to remind the Orissa justice system where their duty lay. As a witness in the assault on Fr. Thomas Chellan, the Catholic priest who too had sought to hide from the mobs before they were caught, she raped, and he beaten to within an inch of his life, Sr. M's experience was once again traumatizing. In 2008, she was still recovering from her wounds - to her body and her psyche. The targeted violence was then at last grabbing headlines internationally, and the Indian media, especially in Orissa, was trying its best to minimize the damage to the state's reputation by either trivializing the Nun's trauma, or in vile insinuations.⁵

It was in these circumstances that Sr. M decided to tell her story. She came to face more than 200 TV, Radio and press correspondents from all over the world at a press conference in New Delhi's Indian Social Institute. She was much too shaky, and her statement was read out by someone else to the media. Sr. M is a Tribal woman of Orissa. This is what Sr. M said that afternoon of October 24, 2008, narrating what she underwent, as demonic assailants professing allegiance to an ideology of religious nationalism, targeted her fellow Christian men and women in Kandhamal.

On 24th August, around 4:30 pm, hearing the shouting of a large crowd, at the gate of Divyajyoti Pastoral Centre, I ran out through the back door and escaped to the forest along with others. We saw our house going up in flames. Around 8:30 pm we came out of the forest and went to the house of a Hindu gentleman who gave us shelter. On 25th August, around 1:30 pm, the mob entered the room where I was staying in that house; one of them slapped me on my face, caught my hair and pulled me out of the house. Two of them were holding my neck to cut off my head with axe. Others told them to take me out to the road; I saw Fr. Chellan also being taken out and being beaten. The mob consisting of 40-50 men was armed with lathis, axes, spades, crowbars, iron-rods, sickles etc. They took both of us to the

main road. Then they led us to the burnt down Janavikas building saying that they were going to throw us into the smouldering fire.

When we reached the Janavikas building, they threw me to the verandah on the way to the dining room that was full of ashes and broken glass pieces. One of them tore my blouse and others my undergarments. Father Chellan protested and they beat him and pulled him out from there. They pulled out my saree and one of them stepped on my right hand and another on my left hand and then a third person raped me on the verandah mentioned above. When it was over, I managed to get up and put my petticoat and saree. Then another young man caught me and took me to a room near the staircase. He opened his pants and was attempting to rape me when they reached there. I hid myself under the staircase. The crowd was shouting "where is that sister, come let us rape her, at least 100 people should rape." They found me under the staircase and took me out to the road. There I saw Fr. Chellan was kneeling down and the crowd was beating him. They were searching for a rope to tie both of us together to burn us in fire. Someone suggested making us parade naked. They made us walk on the road till Nuagoan market which was half a kilometre from there. They made to fold our hands and walk. I was with petticoat and saree as they had already torn away my blouse and undergarments. They tried to strip even there and I resisted and they went on beating me with hands on my cheeks and head and with sticks on my back several times.

When I reached the market the market place about a dozen of OSAP policemen were there. I went to them asking to protect me and I sat in between two policemen but they did not move. One from the crowd again pulled me out from there and they wanted to lock us in their temple mandap. The crowd led me and Fr. Chellan to the Nuagaon block building saying that they will hand us over to BDO. From there along with the block officer the mob took us to police outpost Nuagaon, other policemen remained far. The mob said that they will come back after eating and one of them who attacked me remained back in the police outpost. Policemen then came to police outpost. They were talking very friendly with the man who had attacked me and stayed back. In police outpost we remained until the inspector in charge of Balliguda with his police team came and took us to Balliguda. They were afraid to take us straight to the police station and they kept us sometime in the jeep in the garage; from there, they brought us to the station. The inspector in charge and other government officers took me privately and asked whatever happened to me. I narrated everything in detail to the police, how I was attacked, raped, taken away from policemen paraded half naked and how the policemen did not help me

when I asked for help while weeping bitterly. I saw the inspector writing down. The inspector asked me "are you interested in filing FIR? Do you know what will be the consequence?" At about 10:00 pm I was taken for medical check-up accompanied by a lady police officer to Balliguda Hospital. They were afraid to keep us in police station, saying the mob may attack police station. So the police took us to the IB (Inspection Bungalow) where CRP men were camping.

On 26th August around 9:00 am, we were taken to Balliguda police station. When I was writing the FIR, the constable asked me to hurry up and not to write in detail. When I started writing about the police, the constable told me "this is not the way to write FIR, make it short". So I re-wrote it for the third time in one and half page. I filed the FIR but I was not given a copy of it. At around 4:00 pm the inspector in charge of Balliguda police station along with some other government officers put us in the OSRTC bus to Bhubaneswar along with other stranded passengers. Police were there till Rangamati where all passengers had their supper. After that I did not see the police. We got down near Nayagarh and travelled in a private vehicle and reached Bhubaneswar around 2:00 am on 27th August. State Police failed to stop the crimes, failed to protect me from the attackers, they were friendly with the attackers. They tried their best that I did not register an FIR, not make complaints against police, police did not take down my statement as I narrated in detail and they abandoned me half of the way. I was raped and now I don't want to be victimized by the Orissa police. I want CBI enquiry. "

It is not easy to make such a statement. The eight years have been painful at every step of the encounter with the justice administration system. Although she is a member of the powerful Catholic Church, she fights this battle all-alone. So do the independent pastors, their wives and daughters, most of the time.

ANNEXURE - III

Case Study – Chhattisgarh

Christians in Chhattisgarh especially in the Bastar area have been facing massive politically inspired opposition, which has manifested itself in the form of physical violence and social discrimination. The apathy, impunity and partisanship of the

administration at various levels has compounded the human tragedy, and the gravity of the violation of Constitutional guarantees of Freedom of Expression, Freedom of Association and Movement, and most important, the Freedom of Religion and Belief.

The current wave of incidents against Christians first came into light in May 2014 when Christian families were denied ration and ration cards after they refused to bow down to the demands set by the Vishwa Hindu Parishad (VHP). The VHP had asked each Christian family to contribute 200 rupees per member towards Hindu festivities initiated by the VHP in Sirisguda village. The Christians who had always contributed money during village festivals by their free will could not comply as the money demanded was too much, and the Christians are poor. This resulted in their being denied food for more than 2 months. The village leadership kept silent.

When Christians reported this matter to the district authorities, activists of the VHP and the Bajrang Dal, which is also very active in the region, beat them up. The Gram Sabha, the village council, of Sirisguda passed a resolution outlawing non-Hindu faiths from the village. A section of the Panchayat Raj Act (129 G) was used to adopt a resolution proscribing all religious activity in the village areas which did not adhere to the Hindu faith. Even the Collector of the District, Mr. Ankit Anand, who is the highest civil servant and administration of the region, admitted was against the law.

Since then, according to media reports, more than 60 villages have passed similar resolutions in the area. There have been frequent reports between July 2014 and now of Christians being beaten up in Bastar District in various places including Sirisguda, Belar, Gadiya, Parapur etc.

In Madota village, Police Station Bhanpuri, District Bastar, Chhattisgarh (about 40 kilometres from Jagdalpur) and its surrounding areas Christian families have had many visits from Hindu groups forcing them to convert to Hinduism or face the consequences. The village has already witnessed an order prohibiting the visit of any Christian pastor or leader who is not a local of Madota village. No such rule exists for leaders of the VHP who frequent the village.

On 14th September, Christians gathered peacefully at the Carmel Pentecostal Church near Madota village were attacked by members of Bajrang Dal and VHP. As the Chhattisgarh Lok Swantrya Sangathan, the state unit of People's Union for Civil Liberties, a prominent national Human Rights group noted, "When the Christian community was conducting worship in their Church, 30-35 karyakartas [cadres] of the Vishwa Hindu Parishad entered the church, gave slogans of "Isaiyon ko maro, Ramrajya leke aao", [Eliminate the Christians, Bring in the Kingdom of Lord Rama] and began beating up the persons present, including women and children. They threatened the members of Christian community present there that if they did not come back into their old religion i.e. the Hindu fold, they would not be allowed to drink water from the communal water sources, they would not be allowed to reap their harvests and would be dispossessed of their lands, and might even lose their lives. The Christian community tried to register a complaint at the local police station at Bhanpuri, however the Town Inspector (TI - Stationhouse Officer), he refused to register an FIR [First Information Report]."

"On 16 September 2014, 40-50 members of the Christian community went to the District Head Quarters at Jagdalpur and informed the Superintendent of Police regarding the above incident. The SP Jagdalpur directed the Inspector of Police Station to go to the village and effect a compromise between the two communities. On 19 September 2014, the Inspector of the Bhanpuri police station summoned both parties to the dispute to come to the Police Station. The leaders of the Vishwa Hindu Parishad - Yogendra Kaushik and Surendra Yadav – both residents of Jagdalpur, also went to the Police Station. They threateningly told the Police Officer that he should not get involved in this issue and that only their writ would run in Madhota village. They told the Christians that they must get re-converted to the Hindu fold otherwise they would face consequences. Slogans of "Bajrang Bali" were shouted in the Thana itself. The TI then advised the Christian pastors who had accompanied the villagers not to enter the village, and not to conduct any collective prayer meetings. The villagers and the Pastors had no choice but to obey."

On 9th October the local BJP MLA Dinesh Kashyap led an event at Kunkuda village, in which he claimed to re-convert to Hinduism, 33 Christians from 10 families. The VHP Jagdalpur unit organized the program and Dinesh Kashyap not only presided over the event but also washed the feet of the people being

reconverted. Christians in the area have reported that the re-conversion ceremony was a farce and that already Hindu members were paraded as Christians who are embracing Hinduism.

The event raises important questions as to the role of Mr. Kashyap who is the brother of Kedar Kashyap, the BJP Member of Parliament from the area and the law. As a local MLA does Mr. Kashyap represent the interests of Hindus alone? Was the procedure for conversion, which requires information and permission from the district administration, followed and were affidavits submitted? If not then Mr. Kashyap and the members of the VHP have a lot to answer for.

On 19th October another Church was targeted at Madota village. The PUCL report said: Once again while the Christians were conducting their prayers in the Church, the karyakartas [cadres] of the Vishwa Hindu Parishad surrounded the Church and 5-6 of them entered the Church premises. The people can recognize Daulat, Sadhu, Bhadu, Nauratan and Raju by name and face from amongst these. These people had come with a photo of Bajrang Bali and began to abuse and beat the Christians. They initially wanted to put up the photo of Bajrang Bali in the church, but later they hung it on the borewell and declared that no Christians would be allowed to drink water from the borewell. The people again went to the PS Bhanpuri, where the TI refused to register their complaint. The next day, i.e. on 20th October 2014, they went to meet the SP, district Bastar. The SP not being available, they met the Additional Superintendent of Police Mr. Vijay Pandey, who assured them that he would personally look into the matter. He said that he would come to the village on 25th October 2014 and bring the City Magistrate along with him so that the matter could be resolved.

On 25th October 2014, the Village Kotwar [official] announced by beating of drum that the district authorities would be visiting the village. The Christian community comprising 25-30 families gathered near their Church from 10 am, but none of the officers came to the village. At around 2.30 pm (afternoon), a crowd of about 250-300 people armed with lathis [canes, or staves] came in a procession to the village, and started beating up the Christians including women and children. Some were pursued right up to their houses and beaten there. Many ran away into the adjoining forest. Six Christians were severely injured including a woman whose hand had been fractured. Mr. Bhupendra Khora was informed by the villagers of this and he immediately contacted the SP, Bastar.

Though the SP was not present, Mr. Khora appraised his Reader of the tense situation, and he sent the police force to the village. When the police arrived, the VHP people were still beating the Christians and they ran away after seeing the police. When the ambulance service (called 108 in Chhattisgarh) was called, the Village Kotwar, who is himself a member of the Bajrang Dal and 2-3 others also got into the ambulance along with the injured Christians claiming that they had been hurt by the Christians, though they had no visible injuries. These persons were also admitted into the hospital. Persons named Bhagirathi, Sadhu, Bhadu, Raju and others of the VHP were detained in bailable offences. The Christian pastors were also detained under Section 151 Criminal Procedure Code.

On 27th October 2014, about 2,000-2,500 persons surrounded the Bhanpuri police station to demand the release of the VHP members. They were however produced before the judicial magistrate and remanded to judicial custody. The Pastors were produced in the SDM's court, but since he was on leave and did not accept the bail bonds, they were also sent to jail.

Under the pressure of the VHP cadres, the injured Christians were discharged from the hospital, whereas the VHP persons with hardly any injuries continue to be admitted there.

The PUCL noted that "the Christian community in Village Madhota is in terror. They are not being allowed to access the communal sources of water nor to harvest their crops. No Christian is being allowed to leave the village since the two roads leading from the village, one towards Bhanpuri and the other towards Jagdalpur are being guarded by the VHP persons. Many Christians are outside the village and unable to enter the village for fear. The Pastors are facing death threats if they enter the village."

The PUCL said the main source of the impunity of the VHP members is because they are being fully supported by Mr. Kedar Kashyap, Minister in the Chhattisgarh government who is carrying out a campaign of "Ghar Vapasi" in which Christians are being re-converted to Hinduism often forcibly. The District President of the VHP – Surendra Yadav – and the Janpad Panchayat Member of neighboring Village Usuri who is a BJP as well as VHP leader of the area and his close aide Mohan Mourya are inciting and mobilizing the villagers of Madhota and surrounding villages to attack the Christian community.
